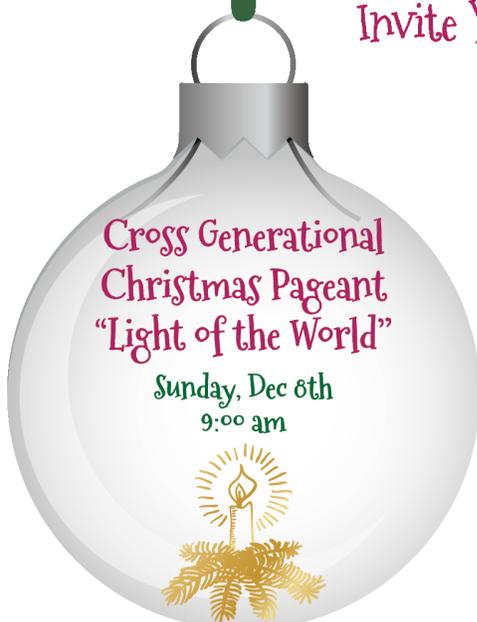

Now that those lights have been updated to LED's, it's a good time to think about switching out your old bulbs at home. LEDs last at least 15x longer and use about 90% less energy than traditional bulbs.

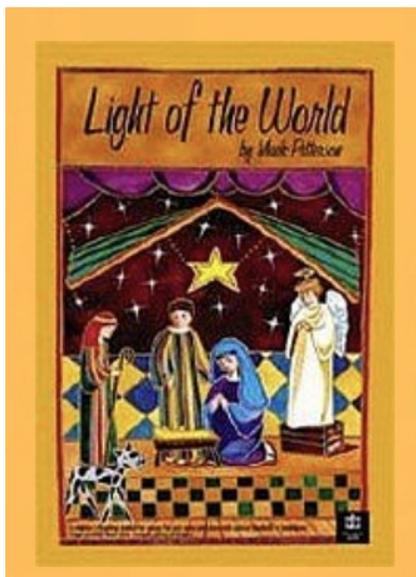
- Made 253 units of affordable rental housing available.
