

PREACHING TEXT


Acts 2:1-18

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. ²And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. ³Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. ⁴All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.

⁵Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. ⁶And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. ⁷Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? ⁸And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? ⁹Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, ¹¹Cretans and Arabs—in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power." ¹²All were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" ¹³But others sneered and said, "They are filled with new wine."

¹⁴But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them, "Men of Judea and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say. ¹⁵Indeed, these are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only nine o'clock in the morning. ¹⁶No, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: ¹⁷'In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams. ¹⁸Even upon my slaves, both men and women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY BAPTISM of KENNEDY ANDERSON

ONE: God's love is a gift that is freely given to us. Jesus' love is always moving towards us. In this sacrament of baptism we are claimed by God's amazing grace, love and salvation. Through our baptisms God calls us into the world for the thriving of our neighbor... that's vocation. Vocation is what it means to live our faith in all areas of our life. By water and the Word, God delivers us from sin and death and raises us to a life of meaning in Jesus Christ. We are anointed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and we are part of God's mission.

ONE: Called by the Holy Spirit, trusting in the love of God, do you desire to have Kennedy baptized? SPONSORS & PARENTS: Yes, with God's help.

ONE: When you bring Kennedy to receive the gift of baptism, you are entrusted with responsibilities: to live with your child among God's faithful people, bring your child to the word of God and the holy supper, teach your child the Prayer Jesus Taught Us, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, place in your child's hands the holy scriptures, and nurture your child in faith and prayer, so that they may learn to trust God, proclaim Christ through their vocations, care for others and the world God made, and work for justice and peace. Do you promise to empower Kennedy to grow in the Christian faith and life?

SPONSORS & PARENTS: Yes, with God's help.

ONE: People of Peace, do you promise to support Kennedy and family in faith and life? **MANY: Yes, with God's help.**

Stand as you are able.

ONE: Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God? **MANY: I renounce them.**

ONE: Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God? **MANY: I renounce them.**

ONE: Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God? **MANY: I renounce them.**

ONE: Do you believe in God the Father?

MANY: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

ONE: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

MANY: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; who descended to the dead. On the third day Christ rose again; Christ ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. Christ will come to judge the living and the dead.

ONE: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

MANY: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

Please be seated.


ONE: Kennedy Anderson, I baptize you in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen. Let us pray. We give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Holy Spirit you give your daughters and sons the joy and abundance of life that surrounds us now and into eternity. Sustain Kennedy with the gift of your Holy Spirit: the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit Of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence, both now and forever.

ALL: AMEN.

ONE: Kennedy, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ forever.

Let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify our God in heaven. Let us welcome the newly baptized:

MANY: We welcome you into the body of Christ and into the mission we share. Join us in giving praise to God for grace and our vocation in God's world. Amen.



+PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION

ONE: Let us pray for the nations, for all of God's creation, for the church and all who struggle. Hear us now, O God, as we join our voices and come before you in prayer...



ONE: We pray for the people of all nations, that government officials will lead with wisdom and compassion, making decisions that empower the most vulnerable. We pray for asylum seekers, refugees, and all who have experienced violence. Move us to work for your justice, that peace might come to all homes... *pause*

ONE: We pray for your created world: animal species lost to human consumption, the rising waters and melting glaciers, intensifying weather patterns of excessive rain and drought. Move governments and people to a new way of living that will honor your creation and the creatures you love within it... *pause*

ONE: We pray for your church, and every generation within it, from the smallest child to the wisest elder. We thank you for the gift of this community, as leaders and servants. We celebrate your welcome and practice your hospitality. Help us to look for the gifts and strengths of our siblings in Christ. Teach us how to serve each other with the same love that Jesus served his disciples... *pause*

ONE: We remember those who are preparing to say, "Goodbye." We pray for those who are finding their new normal in grief. Surround them with your loving presence and hold them close as they mourn. We lift up those in our community who are struggling with physical and mental health concerns, stressful situations, and all who could use your grace. We especially name before you... that all might live secure in the knowledge of your abiding presence through the power of the Spirit, who hears us as we sing......

MANY: (sung, as above: O Lord, hear my prayer, ...)

ONE: The peace of Christ be with you all. **MANY: And also with you.** ONE: Let us share a sign of God's peace with one another. Like the murmur of the dove's song, like the challenge of her flight, like the vigor of the wind's rush, like the new flame's eager might: come, Holy Spirit, come.

To the members of Christ's body, to the branches of the vine, to the church in faith assembled, to our midst as gift and sign: come, Holy Spirit, come.

With the healing of division, with the ceaseless voice of prayer, with the power to love and witness, with the peace beyond compare: come, Holy Spirit, come.
