

PREACHING TEXT

Galatians 4:1-7

Let me show you the implications of this. As long as the heir is a minor, she has no advantage over the slave. Though legally she owns the entire inheritance, she is subject to tutors and administrators until whatever date the parents have set for emancipation. That is the way it is with us: When we were minors, we were just like slaves ordered around by simple instructions (the tutors and administrators of this world), with no say in the conduct of our own lives.


But when the time arrived that was set by God the Father, God sent the Son, born among us of a woman, born under the conditions of the law so that he might redeem those of us who have been kidnapped by the law. Thus we have been set free to experience our rightful heritage. You can tell for sure that you are now fully adopted as God's children because God sent the Spirit of the Son into our lives crying out, "Papa! Father!" Doesn't that privilege of intimate conversation with God make it plain that you are not a slave, but a child? And if you are a child, you're also an heir, with complete access to the inheritance.

the forgiveness of sins,


the resurrection of the body,
