

CALL TO WORSHIP


ONE: God of abundance, the land we walk on is holy ground.


Send forth your grace to help us heal the wounds of this world.




MANY: we confess our part in a broken world.

your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven.


Give us today our daily bread.


Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us.
