April is National Medication Disposal Month!

How many old, expired or unused medications do you have in your house? Think about your medicine cabinets, kitchen cabinets or night stands. These days, the police say that when someone breaks into your house to steal something, they head for the medicine cabinet, not the money or TV. That's because the unlawful sale of prescription pain medications is very lucrative for criminals.

Here are four reasons you should go through your home today and properly dispose of old, expired or unused medication without delay:

- These medications are a public safety issue leading to accidental poisoning, overdose or abuse.
- The majority of teens abusing drugs get them from the homes of their parents, friends' parents or grandparents.
- Pharmaceuticals can be just as dangerous as illegal drugs if taken inappropriately.
- Unused medications thrown in the trash or toilet can contaminate the water supply or be removed from the trash and used by others.

How should you dispose of unused or old medication? The City of Plymouth has drug deactivation bags for small quantities of medication. These bags can be picked up in the lobby of the Plymouth Public Safety Building. One bag per person. An easy way to dispose of your medication is to take them to a Hennepin County Medicine Dropbox. Go to: https://www.hennepin.us/MEDICINE for the locations. The closest one to Peace Lutheran is at the Ridgedale Government Center in Minnetonka. You cannot return unused, unopen, unexpired prescriptions to pharmacies in Minnesota. If you have medication you would like to donate, you can ask your Faith Community Nurse where to send it.
